

March 2018 Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:03pm with (26) members present.

The minutes for the February meeting, as previously emailed to the members, was approved unanimously by a vote of 26 – 0.

Club Treasure Ken Kayser reported the March Operating Balance of \$8,884.66 with a total bank balance, including the Future Fund of \$7,000.00, of \$15,884.66. Said budget was also unanimously approved by all members present.

OLD BUSINESS

- John Welcome mentioned that the FaceBook page is already up for the War Bird Event and that currently, 32-38 people are tentatively planning on attending. John also mentioned that a DLA-58 would be the main prize raffled off. He finished by saying that at noon time on Saturday they were going to have a foamy “Dog Fight” that has always proved to be blast and fun to watch.
- Ken Blackford reported that the sanction, insurance and advertising documents for the Swap Meet are already turned in and that the insurance waiver has already been sent over to the Fairgrounds. He said that we will actually be in (3) months of issues in Model Aviation. He thanked Rod Stauffer for assisting as the Co-CD. He also asked Tom Dollenmayer if he could help with posting the event on FaceBook like he did last year. Ken Kayser and John Welcome said that we can immediately post an event on the clubs FaceBook as well. John also offered to help post the event on popular websites, such as, RC Groups and RC Universe. Ken Blackford finished by saying that as we get closer to the date of August 4th he will be asking for volunteers to assist himself and Rod. John Welcome offered to give away a pack of Servo Screws to each person that comes through the door. He also stressed that we should really push the size of the space in that also tends to attract more vendors if they know the space is available.

Michael Holbrook reminded the club that we have only approved \$500.00 for the FPV site and that it won’t go very far and asked people to volunteer and help James whenever possible.
