

## **June 2008 Minutes**

The meeting was open at approximately 7:20

Club Treasure, Rod Stauffer reported an operating balance of \$560.96, in addition to the future fund of \$4000.00, as of 6-10-08. Membership, after tonight, would be up to 69.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

- It was reported that parts are still on order for the grill. But, we are getting all burners for the price of one.

- On-going talks about the runway repair are still underway.
