<u>Treasurer Report:</u> Unanimously Approved, Butch Pendergrass, Charlie Lasley, approve & second.

Old Business:

- 1. Chris Baker thanked everyone for their support at the Electric Event.
- 2. Howard reported on the Gravel for the road. The Club took a vote to add \$1k more to the already allotted \$1k for the gravel project.
- 3. Howard also reported on the new mailbox to be placed at the first house on the left coming down Poindexter Rd.
 - a. Two Votes were taken, both passed for the gravel and mailbox projects.

New Business:

 Howard discussed a possible donation of a security system. After much discussion about the pros & cons, the Club Members thought it would not be a good fit at this time. All Club Members felt this was a generous offer and it was greatly appreciated.

2. Noise Pollution, AKA Loud Aircraft:

a. A long discussion about complaints arising from very loud aircraft ensued. One member commented, "when our neighbors can hear Aircraft inside their homes across the river it affects their quality of life." President Howard Bass stated he would tactfully talk with any offenders of our noise policy.

3. Guest Visit Abuse:

- a. The Club has seen an uptick for Guest using our field numerous times without joining. The members present thought this was very unfair to the paying members. "It takes a huge amount of funds to keep our field in pristine condition and for nonmembers to use the field to maiden aircraft or come at will numerously to fly did not sound right or fair." Current Members should not be giving nonmembers an open invitation to come and fly anytime they desire; we must follow Club guidelines. A majority of members present at the meeting felt the By-Laws need to updated badly for these items and more.
- b. A motion was made by Charlie Lasley, second by Dave Hansen to have Treasurer Mike Holbrook send out to the entire membership an outline for a \$20 or \$25 per day guest pass for nonmembers along with how the process would work. The measure passed unanimously. The vote WAS NOT to install the guest pass policy, but to get all members thinking about if such a policy is actually a good idea. If a majority of the full membership likes the guest pass option, we would vote as a club at the appropriate time.
